

Science Wall of Honor

Originally Proposed to the Science & Mathematics Advisory Board on Oct 25, 1996

Revised by the Wall of Honor Committee of the SMAB Board on Sept 25, 2003

1. Intent: To honor those who have distinguished themselves in the sciences and to McMurry University. Plaques will be placed in the Science Building and awarded to the recipients or their families to commemorate their accomplishments.
 2. Membership: A balance between successful alumni and science faculty who have made exceptional contributions to the education of McMurry's science students should be the goal.
 3. Selection Criteria:
 - Alumni- At least two of the following criteria must be met for consideration
 - Should have distinguished record from McMurry
 - Should have been the recipient of significant recognition for their work at the regional and preferably national or international level
 - Should have demonstrated unusual support for McMurry over the years
 - Faculty- At least three of the following criteria must be met for consideration:
 - Should have been a faculty member at McMurry
 - Should have demonstrated unusual excellence in the classroom
 - Should have demonstrated continued excellence of scholarship in the field
 - Should have exhibited exceptional service to the science students of McMurry
 - Special Cases- In some instances, individuals who have made truly outstanding contributions to McMurry but who do not otherwise meet selection criteria may be nominated for inclusion. In such cases, the nominator must make a compelling case for consideration of the individual.
 4. Frequency: Once per year, at the Fall Meeting of the Science & Math Advisory Board (SMAB), potential nominees, not to exceed three, will be reviewed and considered.
 5. Method of Selection: Individuals will be nominated by members of the Science & Mathematics Advisory Board (SMAB), science alumni, and the McMurry community. An individual appointed by the SMAB will serve as the main facilitator for the Wall of Honor selection process. In the case where more than 3 individuals are nominated, the three with the largest affirmative vote by the SMAB board will be the final selection. A cumulative ratio of honorees with equal representation from among alumni and faculty is preferred and desired. Membership of the SMAB will vote for one group of candidates and may utilize this ratio in their decision or they may choose to ignore the ratio for a specific group.
 6. Induction: Individuals elected to the Science Wall of Honor and/or family representatives will be invited to attend as guests of honor a special induction ceremony, at which time the plaques will be unveiled. Plaques will be mounted in the Science Building, and a replica of the plaque will be awarded to the inductee or family representative at this time.
